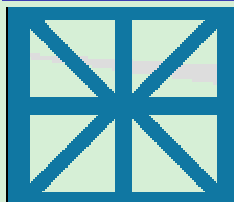

April Vacation Week

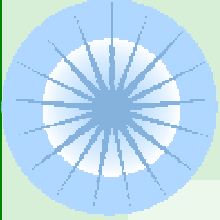
Tired of reading the same old thing? Bring in gently used books from your own bookshelf and swap them for something else. A great way to try new titles.
