DOWNTOWN 110 YEARS AGO: This sketch of Fall River Four Corners, now the heart of the downtown district, shows a portion of the city of the then 20 acres that was levelled in the great fire of 1843. The view generally shows the blocks between Bedford, Central and Pocasset Streets.
