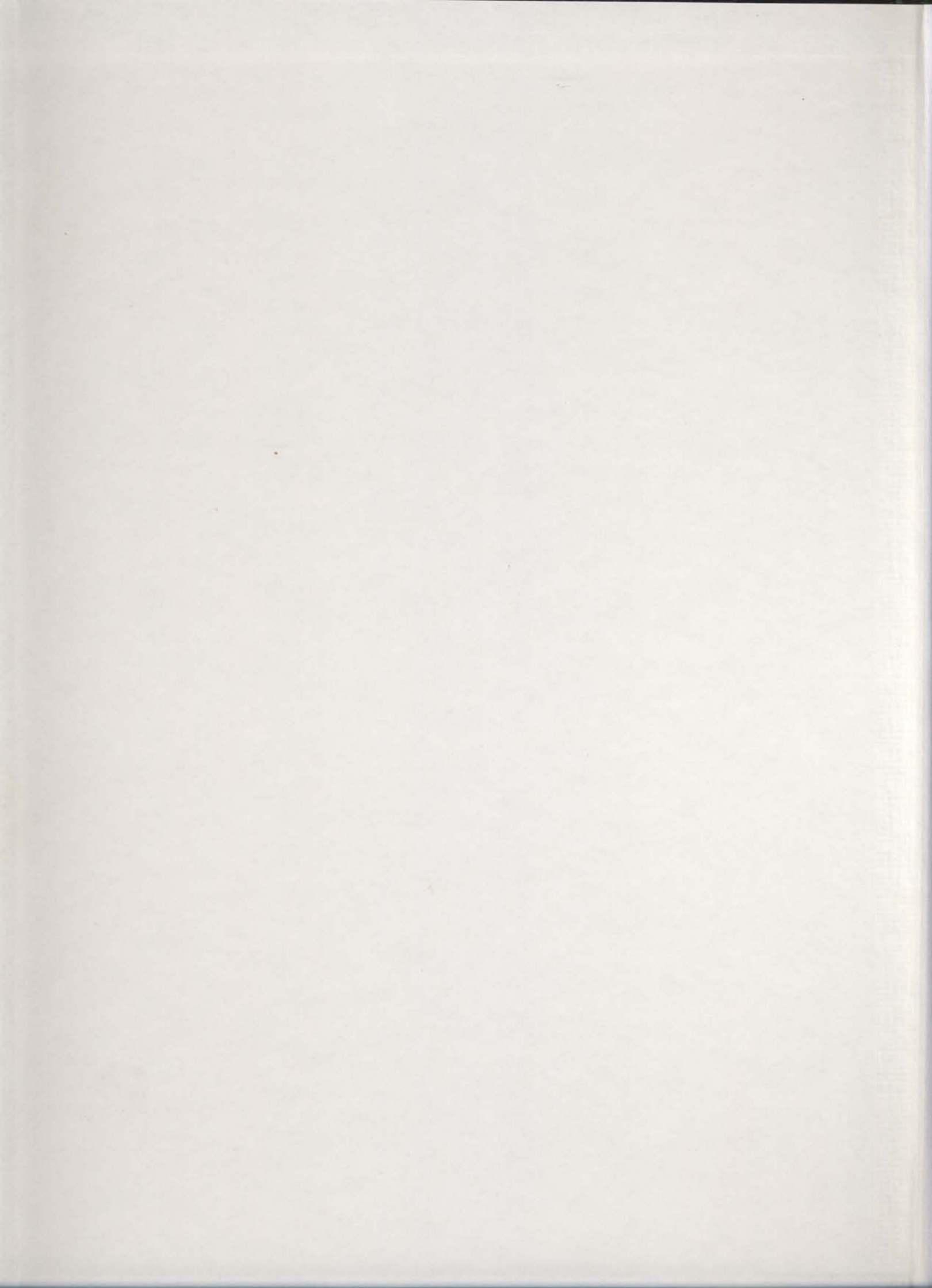

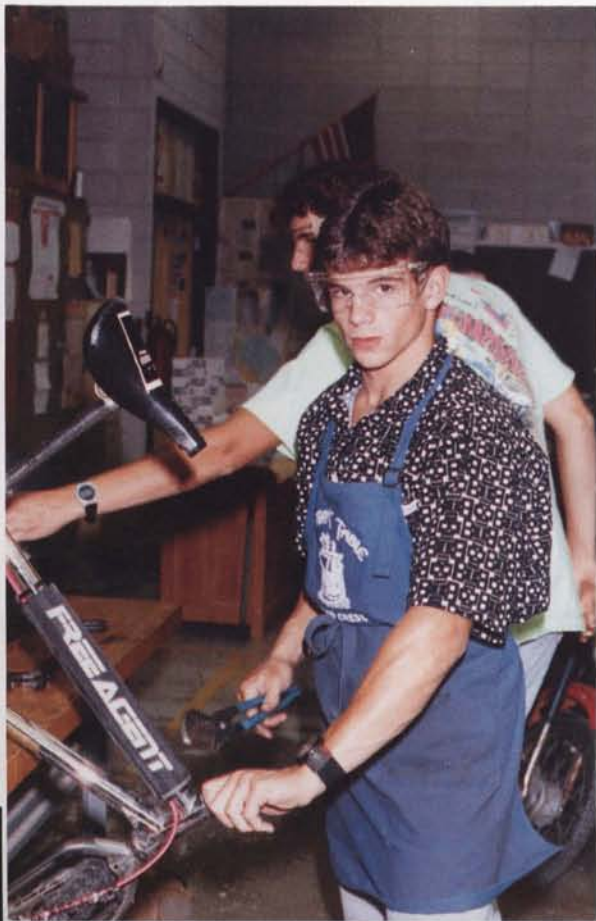
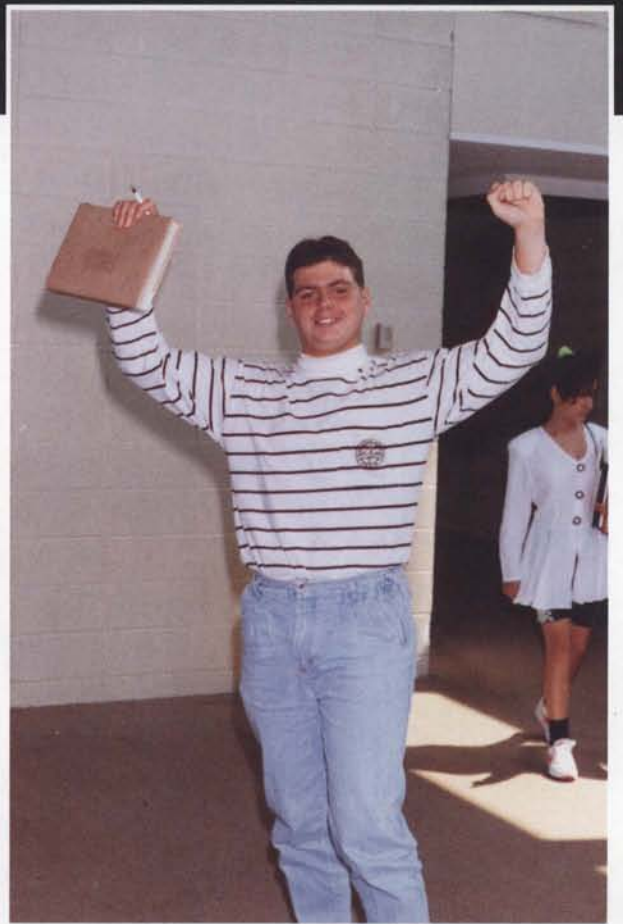

As we tear into the 90's, remember the good times and the bad times that happened in this place you can call home.





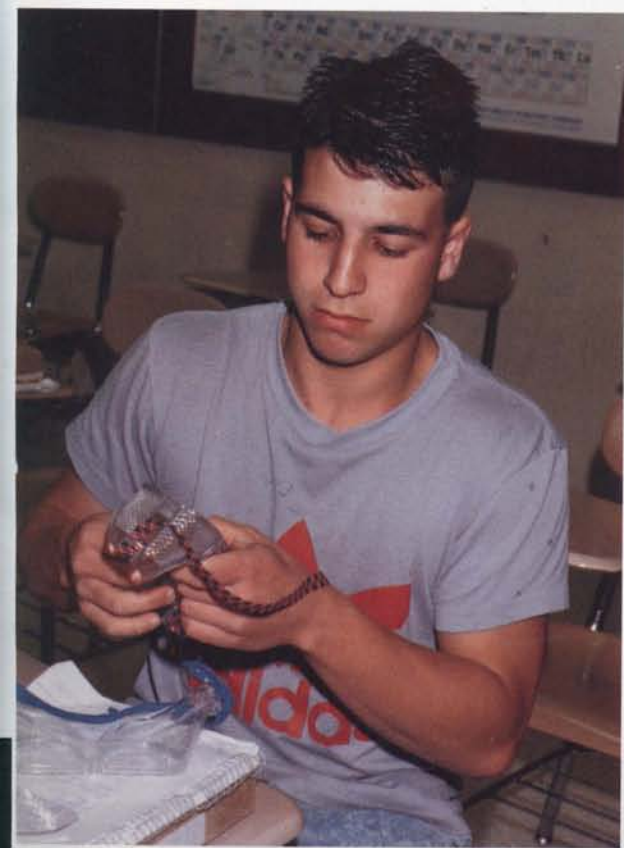
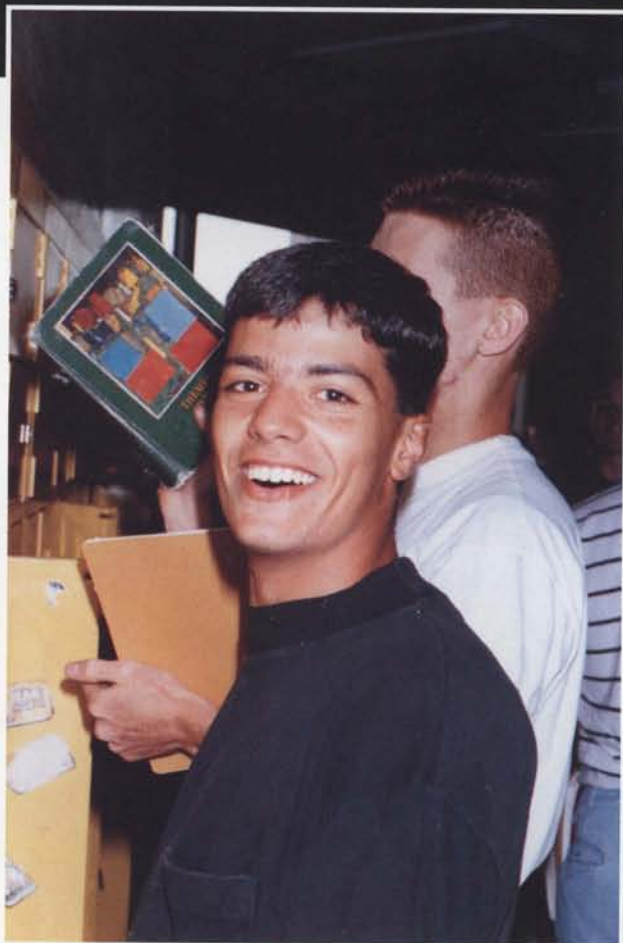
B.M.C. Durfee High School is a community within itself. It is a place where educators and students meet, but also where different values and backgrounds merge.

Aguiar and Wilcox dominated in the hurdles, while Plante showed great skill in pole vaulting, leaving Greg Lewis to take care of the middle distance running.

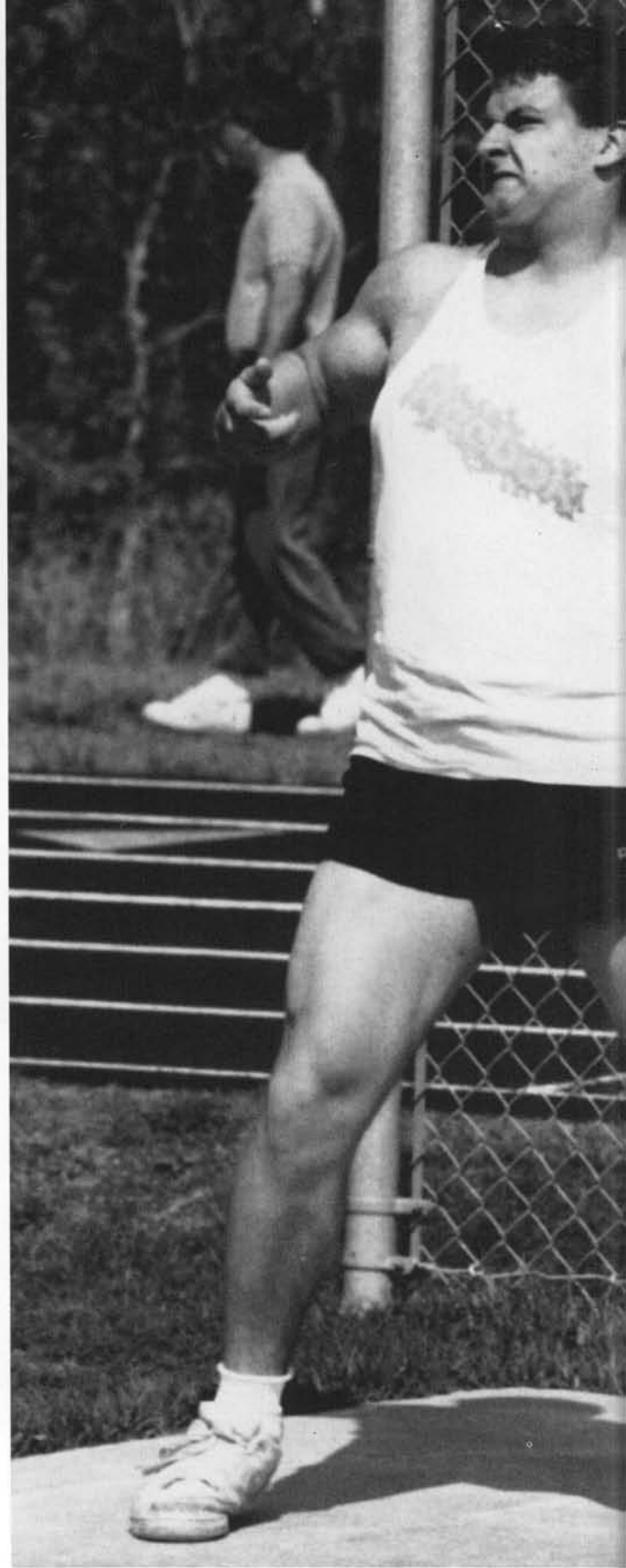

On the whole the 1989-90 Boy's Spring Track team worked together and did their best. By doing this, they posted impressive victories against Barnstable, Diman, and Connolly.

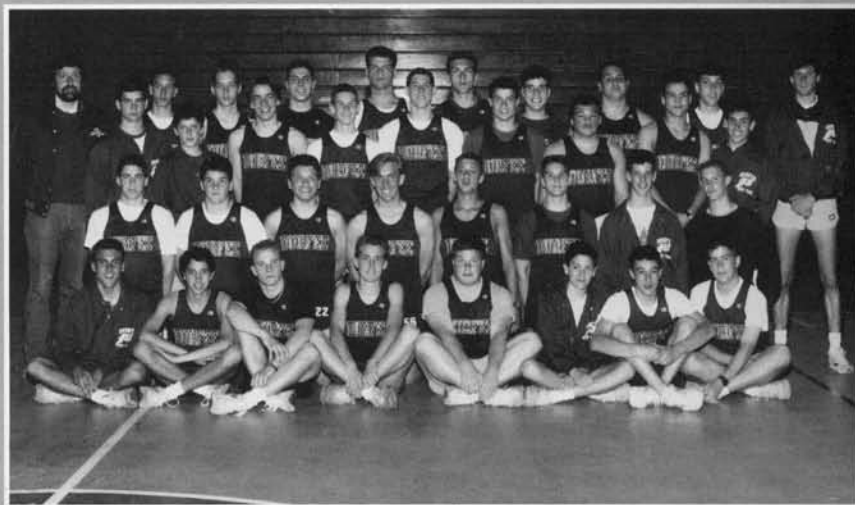

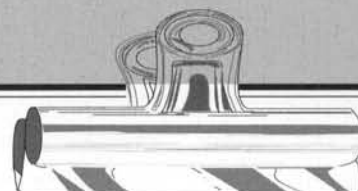

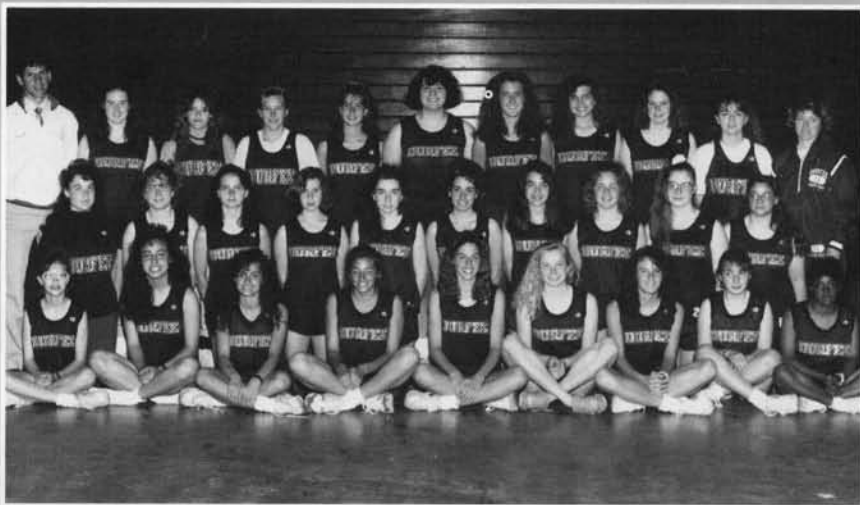

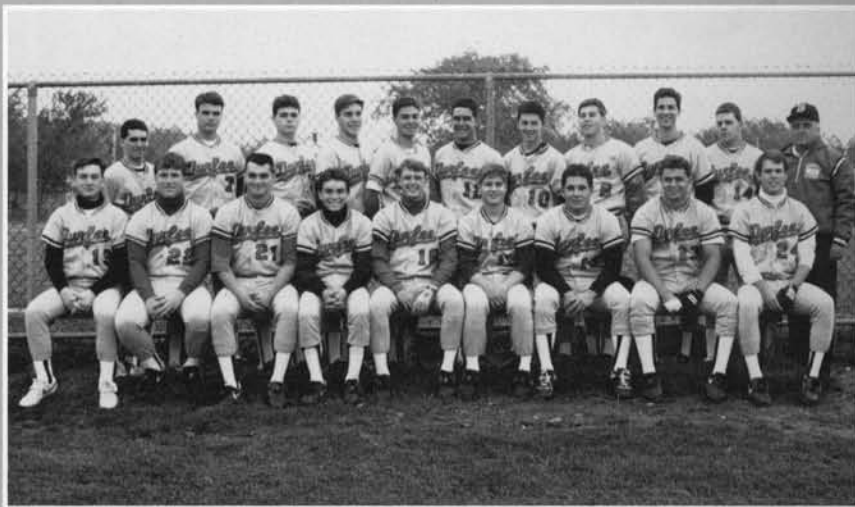

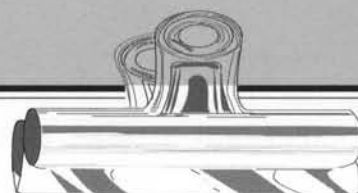

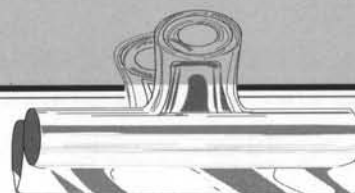

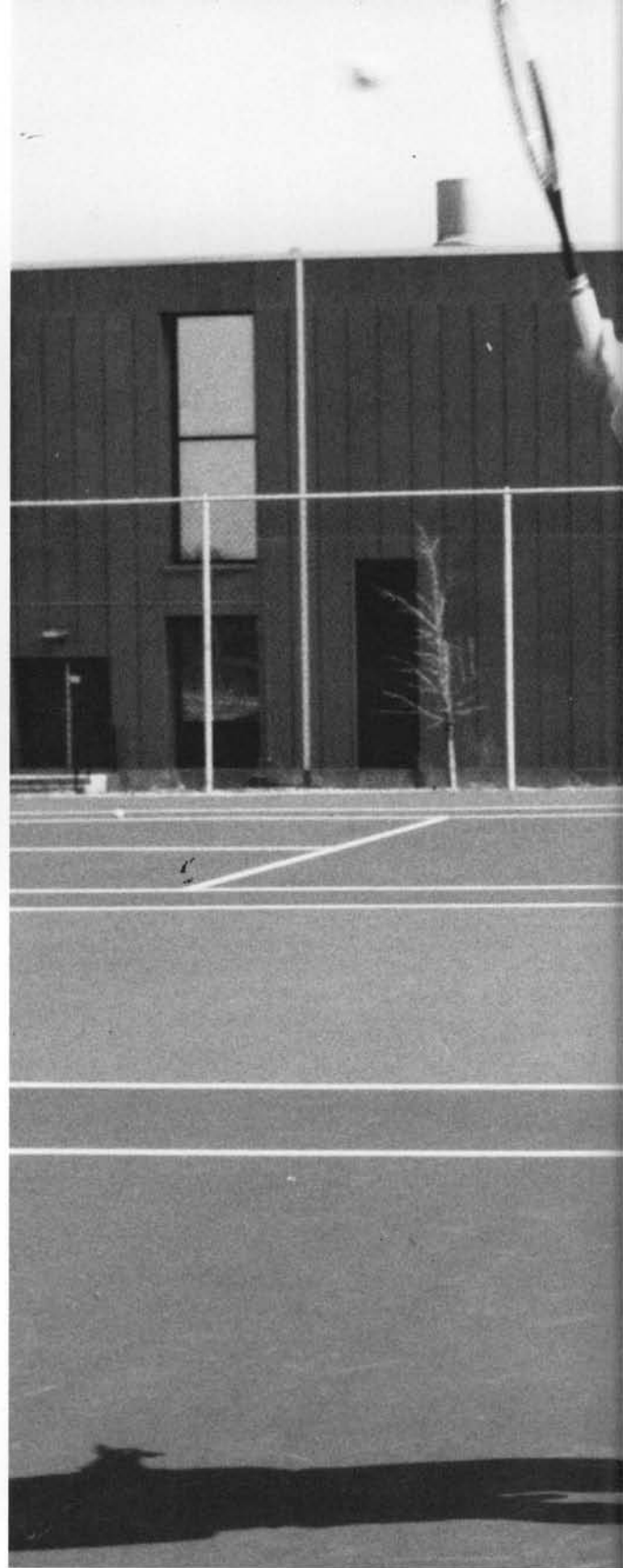
First singles player Dave Parent had a season full of challenging wins despite a leg injury. An additional singles player Erik North was a very big asset. The two also served as co-captains.

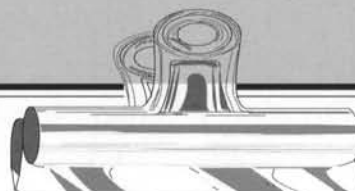

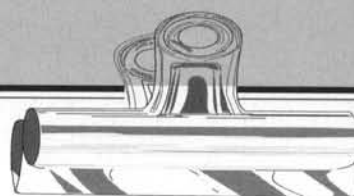

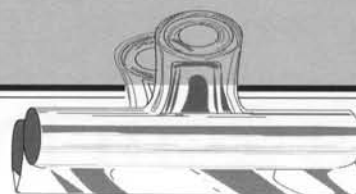

Steve Vieira led the team, crossing the finish line in 52nd place (17:26), followed by Eric Bradbury (18:07), and Aaron Pimental (18:39).

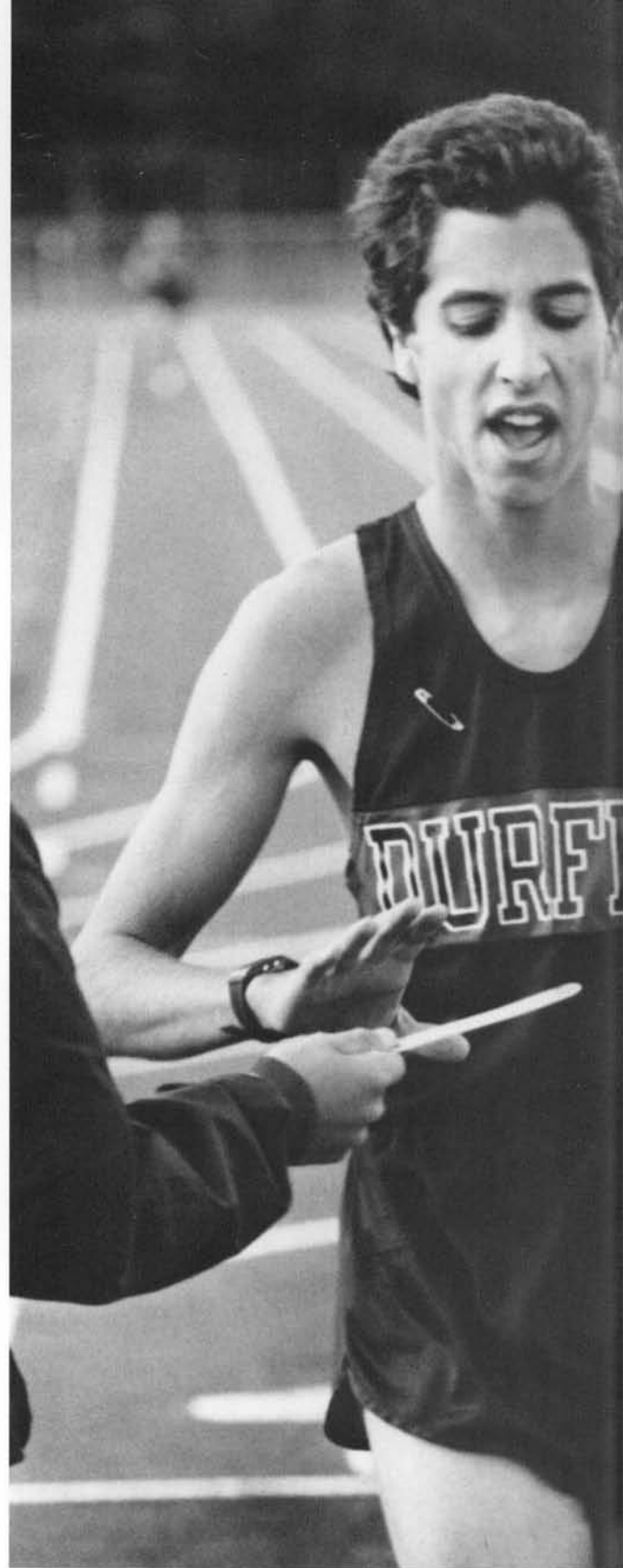
The Durfee runners previously competed on the Franklin Park course in the Catholic Memorial meet.

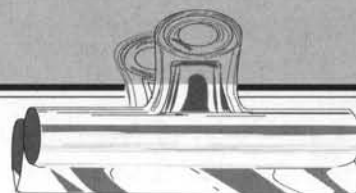

The team loses three excellent seniors this year.

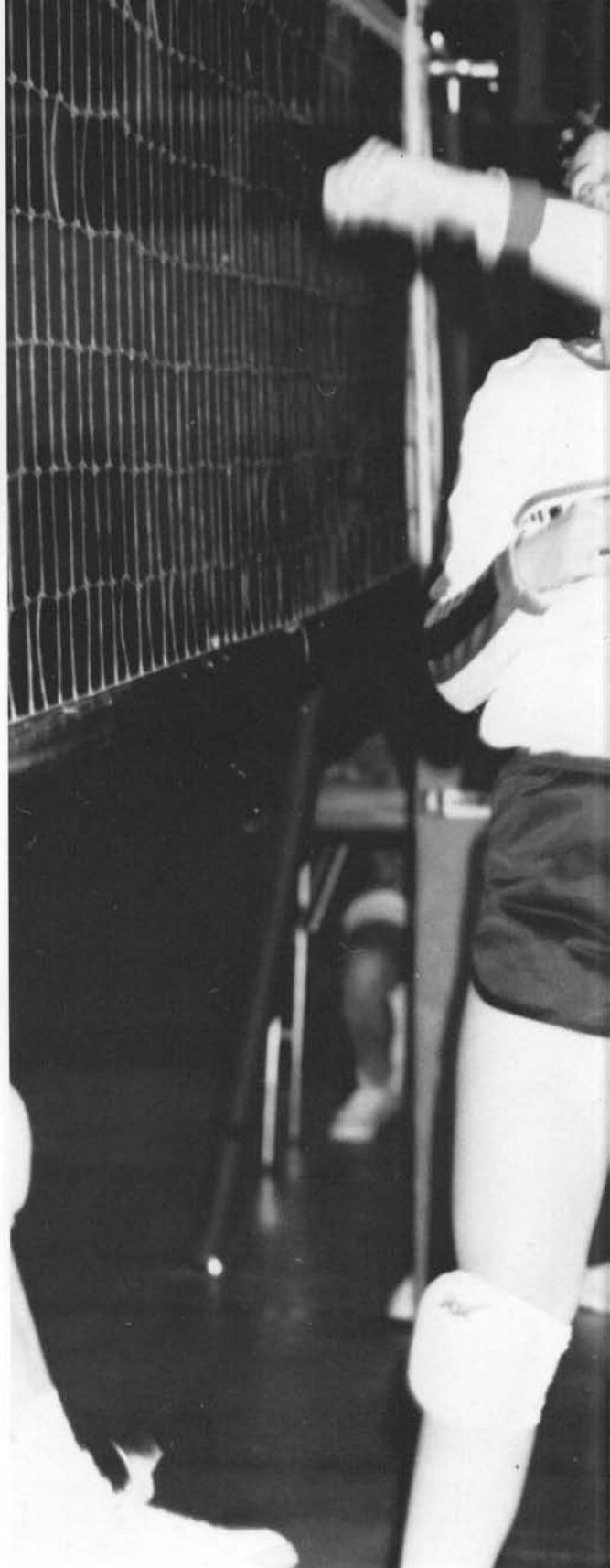

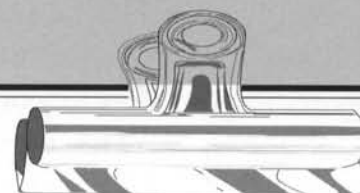

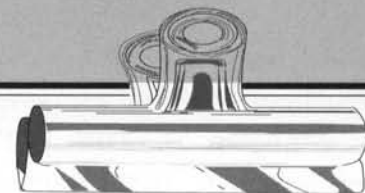

From the outset of the season, Durfee was overmatched having to face such teams as nationally ranked Brockton High School, and tough B.C. High.

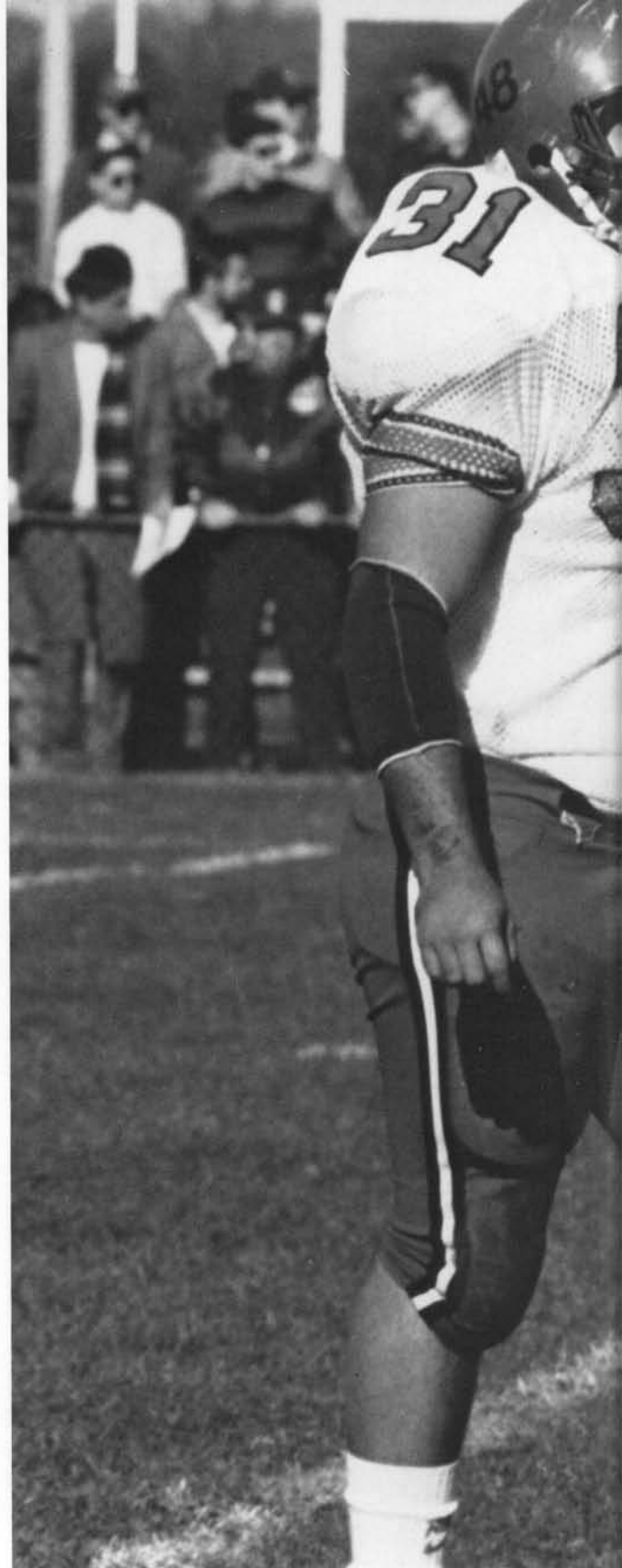
Not withstanding significant defeats to both opponents, the

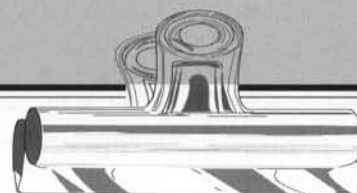

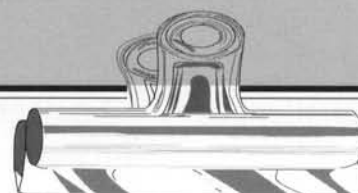

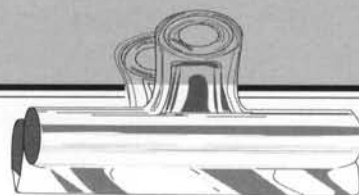

Over the past few years the team has been getting stronger and their records have been getting better. The team has a positive outlook for next year with most of its top swimmers returning.



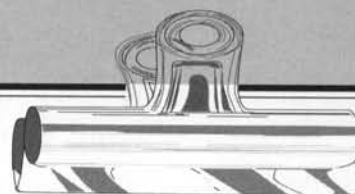

With such a small team the girls aren't able to focus their practices to just one event but on all four.



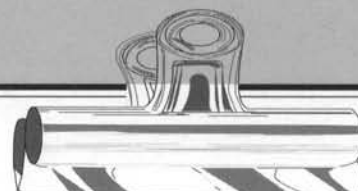

Coach Kitchen is looking forward to her second year coaching the team.



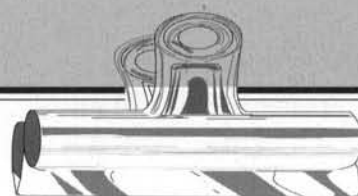

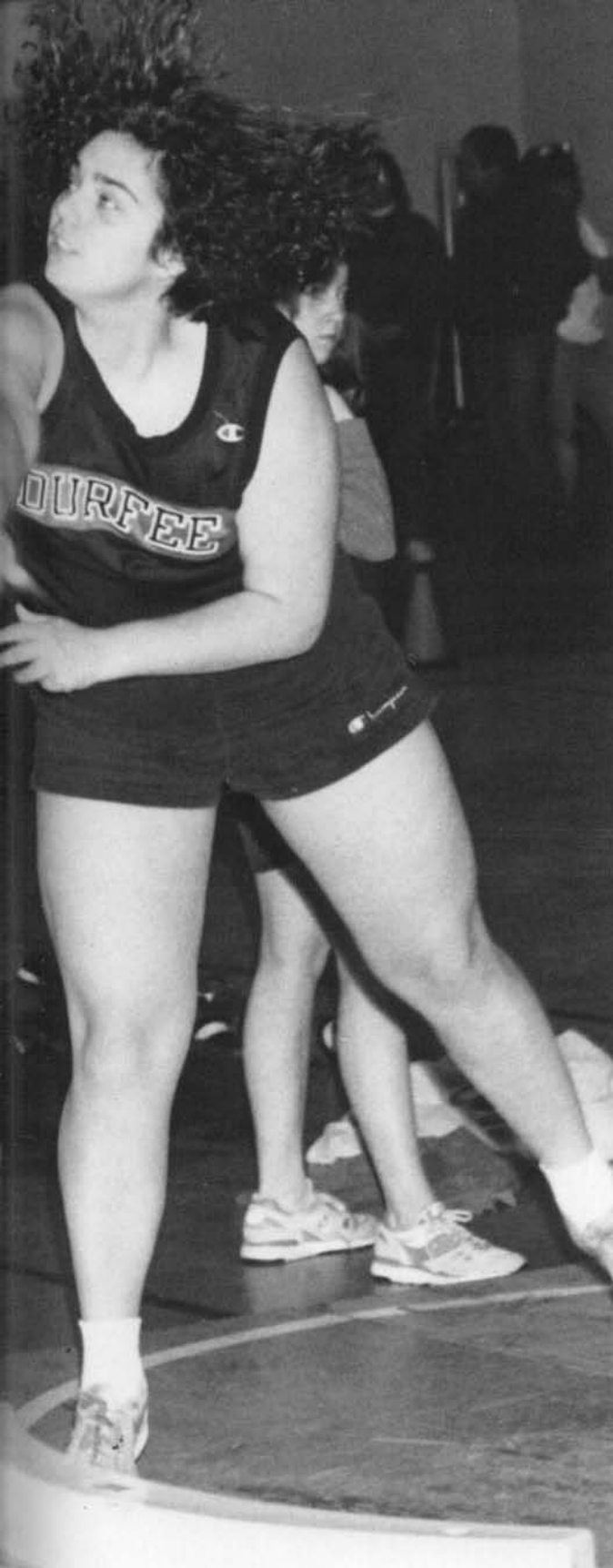

Melissa Cavaco qualifies for states in the shot put.

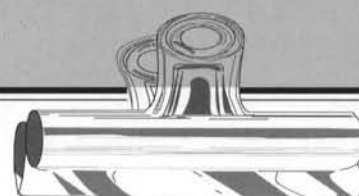

Although they had hoped for a better record, this year holds a certain significance for the team. They tied New Bedford for the first time in forty years.

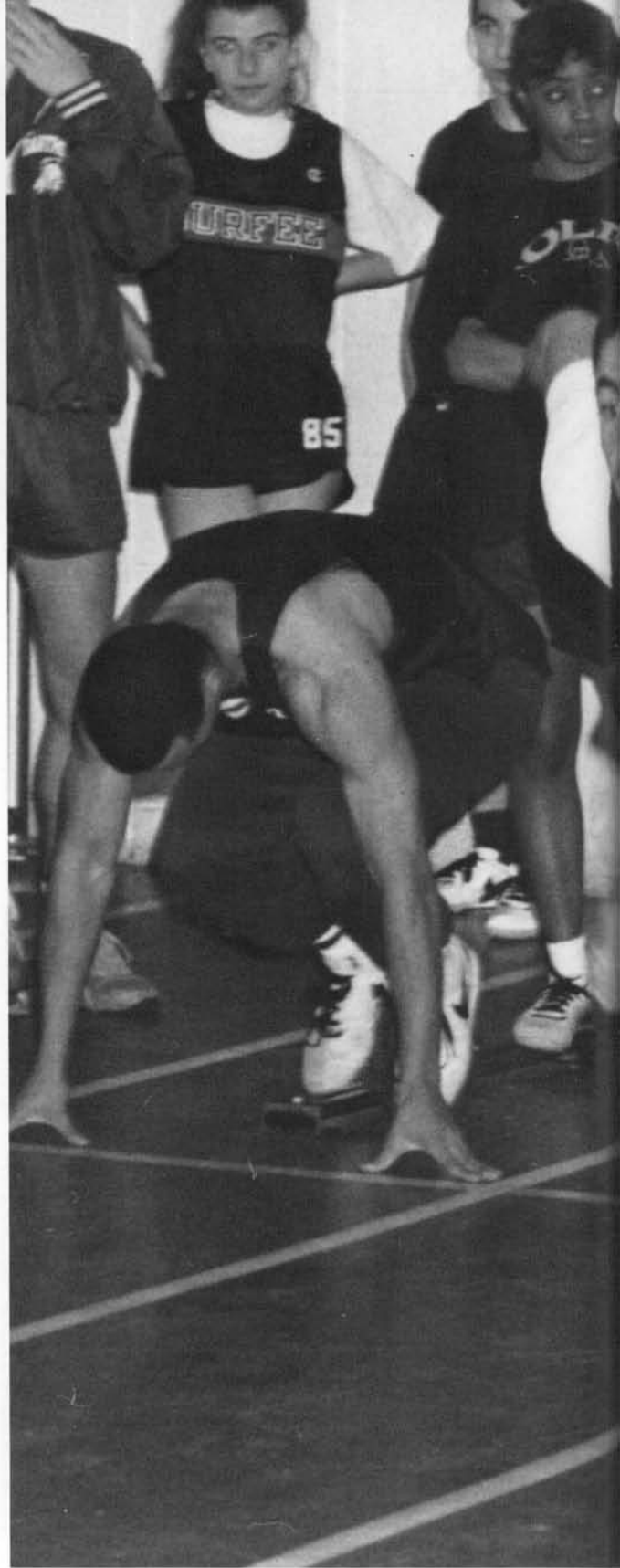
Coach George Moniz was satisfied with the outcome of the season considering the size of the team, but always hopes to do better.

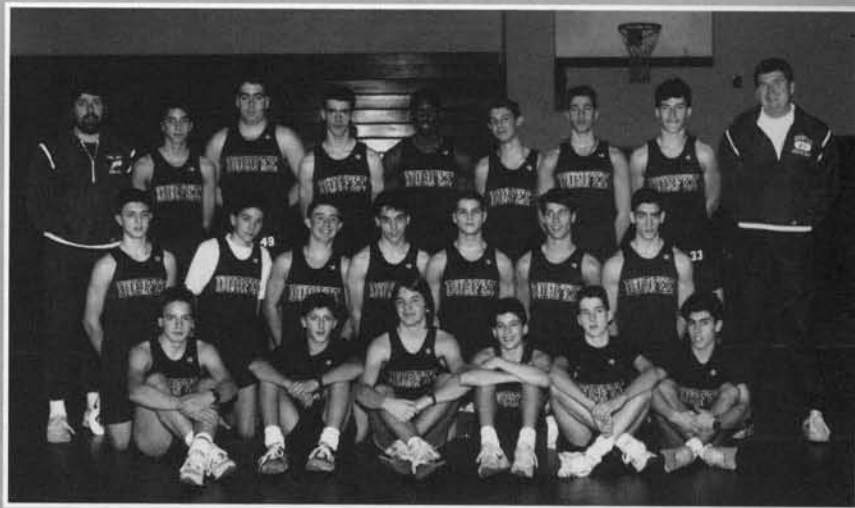
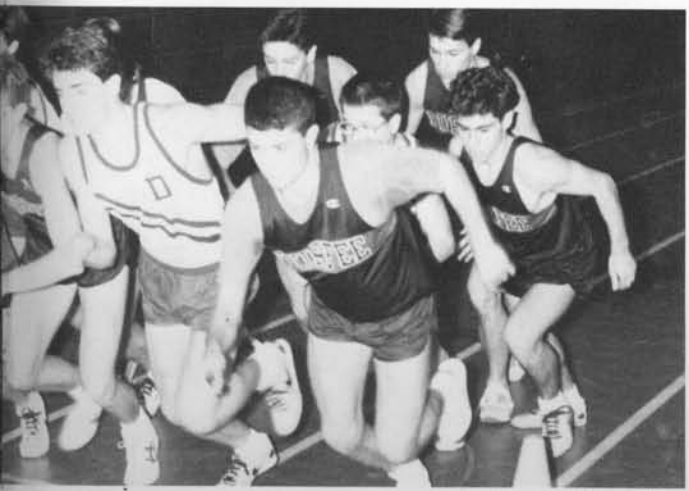

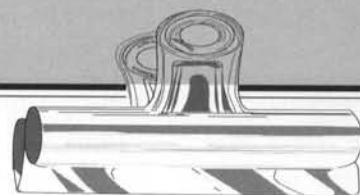

Skaters win first ever league title

Slip-slidin' away!

That's certainly not what the Durfee Hockey team did with their opportunities this season.

The Skaters finished with a record of 11-7-5, and won the first ever Big Three Conference Championship.

In doing so, they qualified for the Division I M.I.A.A. state tournament, a feat that hadn't been accomplished since 1984.

Much of the credit for this season's success goes to senior captain Doug Smith.

Smith, a four-year veteran, became only the second player in Durfee history to score over 100 points in a career, finishing with 112.

However, Smith could not carry the team alone. Senior goalie Shawn Lecomte performed as well as anyone could have expected, limiting the opposition to 3.0 goals per game.

The sextet also received outstanding support from junior offensive powerhouse Eric Bradbury, and fellow sophomore

sticker Kevin Brum, a powerhouse in his own right.

The Toppers fell in the first round of the tournament to Catholic Conference powerhouse Don Bosco, who, while finishing fourth in their league, had a 10-0 regular season record against non-conference teams.

Durfee's lone goal was scored by junior Eric Bradbury, as Don Bosco's goalie, Todd Fisher, stopped 14 shots on net.

Despite the 5-1 loss, Coach Steve Maurer praised his squad. He commented, "I am very pleased and proud of this team." He said, "They never quit, and they deserve all the credit in the world."

In addition to Smith and Lecomte, Durfee will lose only one other senior, Justin Huchel, from this year's team.

Smith feels, "Next year should be an exciting year, with the majority of the team returning. With this experience behind them, hockey fans should be in for a fun season."

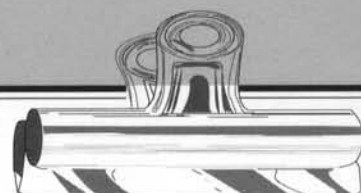

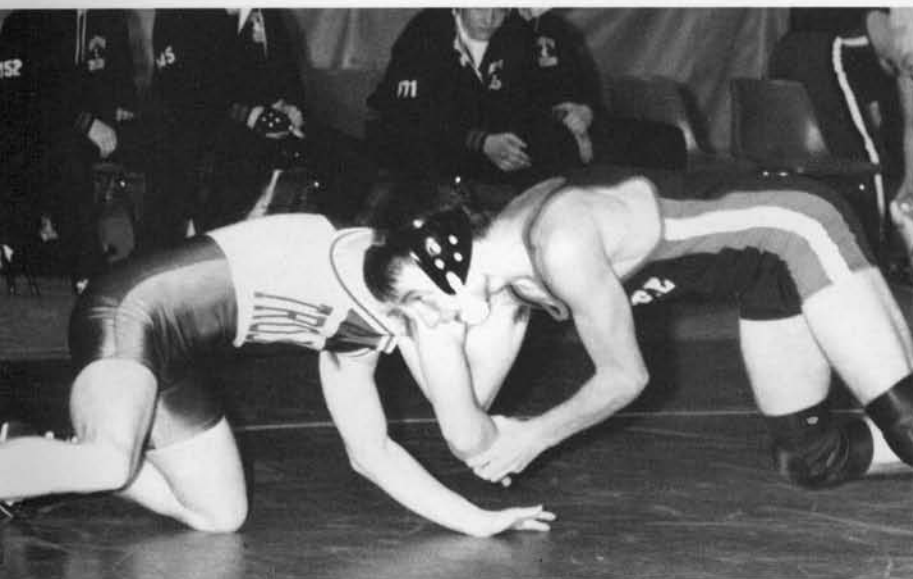

Tri Captains for the 1991 season were Jin Su O, Bob Ragonesi, and Frank Yentz.

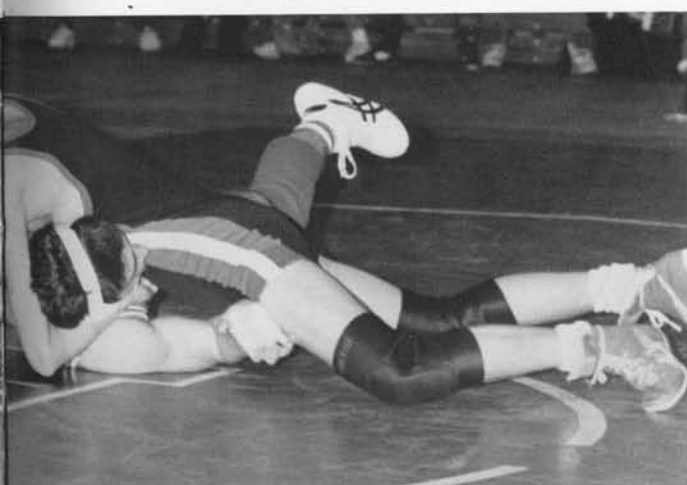

This is a story of a boy with the potential to reach the highest goals, and instead made a decision to take a lethal drug without foreseeing the consequences.

Dougie was a beautiful person. He was friendly and easy to get along with. Everyone who met him couldn't help but be taken in by his meek charm. Girls melted helplessly in the palm of his hand. Regardless of how spellbound anyone was by him, no matter how much he had a hold over anyone, Dougie never intentionally hurt a soul. That's not the way he was.

Of course he wasn't an angel; nobody is. His sister Jen can contest to their spats, and the enjoyment Dougie used to get out of teasing someone. That doesn't change the fact that he possessed a sweetness that some people may never encounter in a lifetime.

Dougie was a fantastic baseball player. He was a pitcher. The intensity level with which he pitched was so great that a fan from the bleachers could see the amount of concentration that went into every pitch. There could be no doubt of his effort.

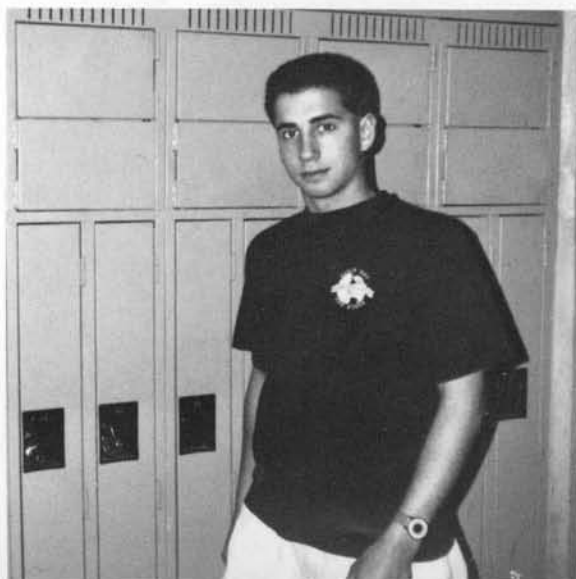
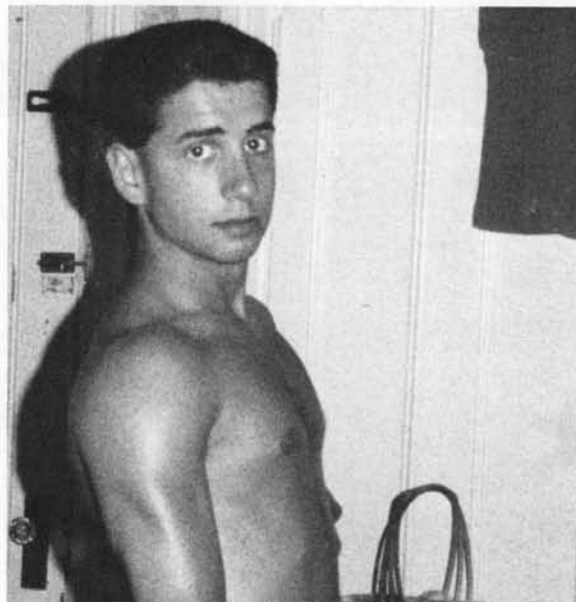
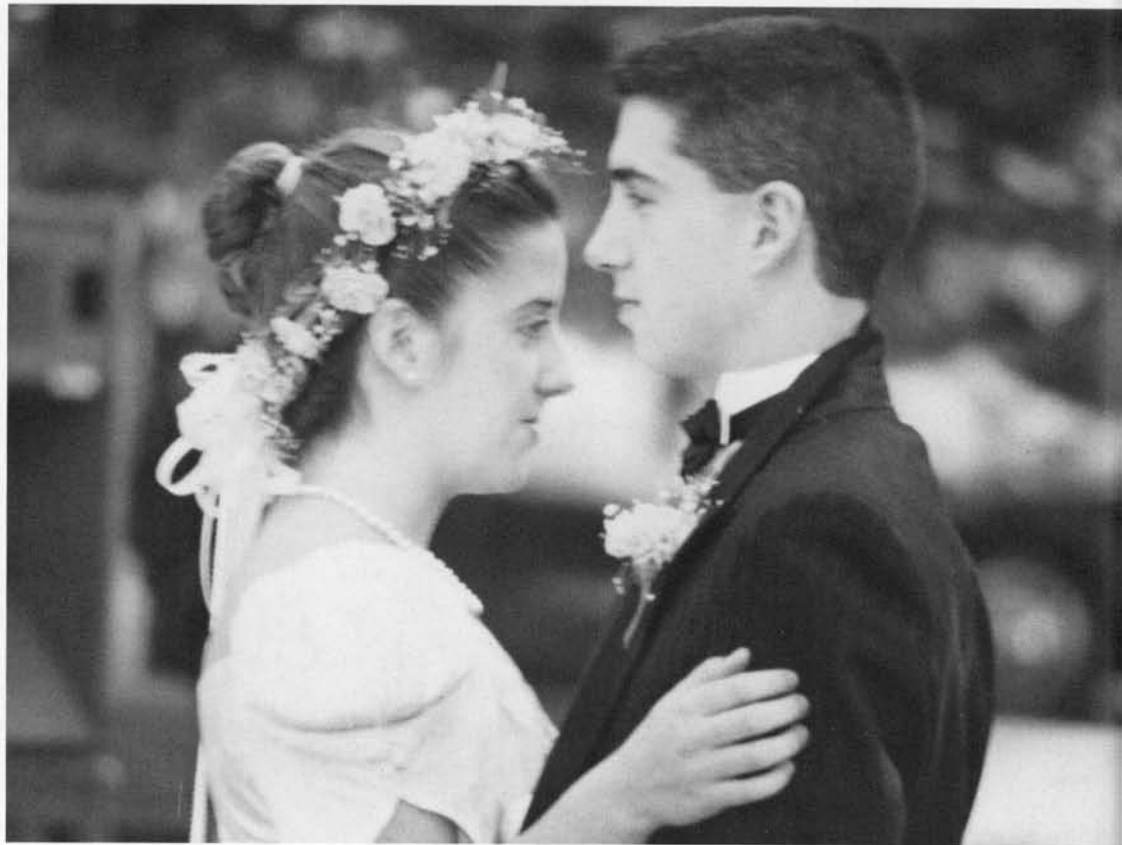
How could such an outstanding individual have something so unexpected happen to him? Only Dougie could answer that, and unfortunately this question will never be answered.

After Dougie's sister, Jen Carvalho, inquired about an anti-drug group being started in Dougie's name, a group of friends went to Mr. Panos with the idea.

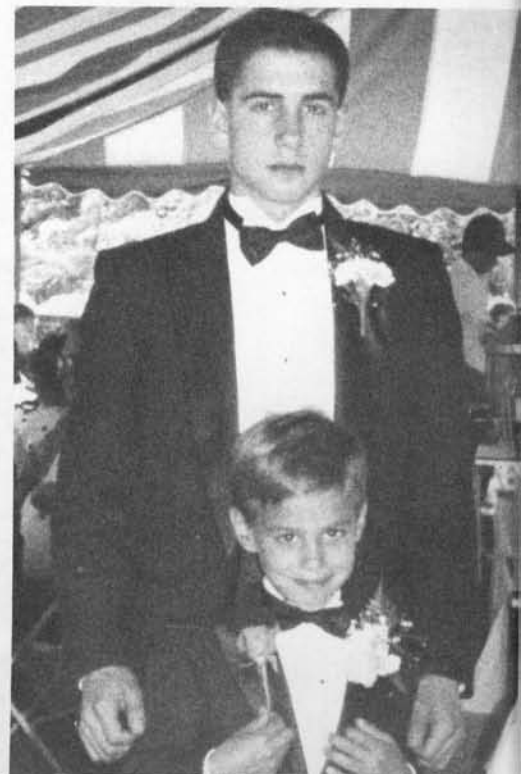
Durfee Against Drugs, D.A.D., was started in Dougie's name. Its chief purpose is to prevent tragedies such as Dougie's from happening in the future.

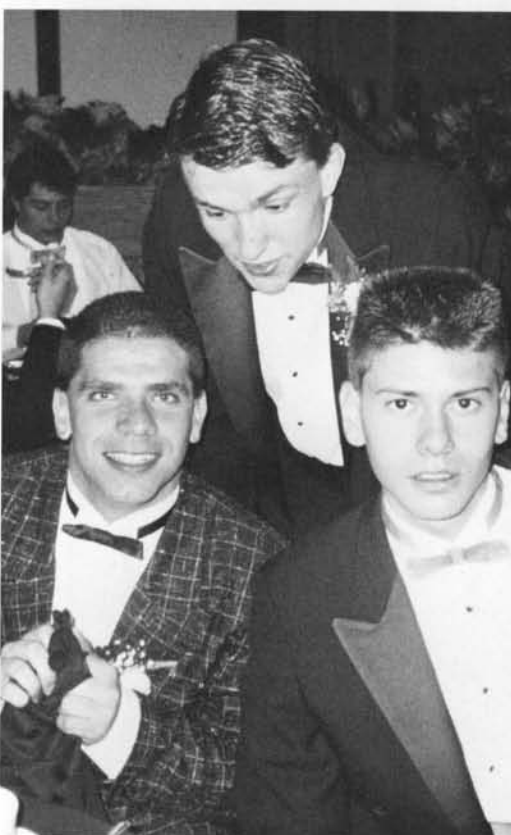
