Look for these new books in large print this month: **MCETTRICKS OF TEXAS, DEAD BY MIDNIGHT, FORBIDDEN FALLS, THE LOST, DOWN RIVER, FANTASY IN DEATH, AMONG THIEVES** (fiction about the 1990 robbery at the Isabella Stewart Gardner Museum), **ABIGAIL ADAMS, THE BRUTAL TELLING, STONES INTO SCHOOLS, STAND-IN WIFE, THEREBY HANGS A TAIL** (the audio of this is a hoot!), **MONEY TO BURN.**

Look for books by these authors this month: **Linwood Barclay, Elizabeth Berg, Mary Higgins Clark, Lisa Lutz, Frances Mayes, Elizabeth Peters, Lisa Scottoline, Stuart Woods, Alexander McCall Smith, and Mark Spragg.**

These new books will be coming out in April:

**Susan Wittig Albert: HOLLY BLUES.** China lets her husband's ex-wife move in!

**David Baldacci: DELIVER US FROM EVIL.** Violence occurs on both sides of the world. One of the characters is from **THE WHOLE TRUTH.**

**Mary Balogh: A SECRET AFFAIR.** Part 5 of the Huxtable Family series.

**C.J. Box: NOWHERE TO RUN.** This is part of the Joe Pickett series (he's a game warden in Wyoming) and it has lots of fans.

**Jim Butcher: CHANGES.** Harry's love, Susan, has run away to South America, but the Red Court is after her. Part of The Dresden Files, about Harry Dresden who is a wizard in Chicago.

**Elizabeth George: THIS BODY OF DEATH.** Library Journal recently mentioned the readers who were upset about the death of Linley's wife (one of those readers is writing this) and said this book might bring some of those readers back. You know who you are! Elizabeth George is an American who writes this series about a detective from Scotland Yard.

**Iris Johansen: EIGHT DAYS TO LIVE.** This is an Eve Duncan thriller.

**Stieg Larsson: THE GIRL WHO KICKED THE HORNET'S NEST. THE GIRL WITH THE DRAGON TATTOO FANS** will want to read this.

**Debbie Macomber: HANNAH'S LIST.** Her list suggests 3 women who might qualify for role of his new wife after she dies.

**Yann Martel: BEATRICE AND VIRGIL.** Martel's LIFE OF PI was very popular. This one concerns atrocities of the Holocaust.

**Sue Miller: THE LAKE SHORE LIMITED.** An estranged wife may be among the victims of a terrorist attack. Miller lives in Massachusetts, became famous for THE GOOD MOTHER.

**Robert Parker: BLUE-EYED DEVIL.** Part of the Appaloosa series...will Callico become president of the U.S.?

**James Patterson: THE 9<sup>TH</sup> JUDGEMENT.** The Women's Murder Club is after another deranged murderer.

**Douglas Preston and Lincoln Child: FEVER DREAM.** Pendergast is sorting through his wife's possessions after her death. Did you know he had a wife? I didn't.

**Anna Quindlen: EVERY LAST ONE.** Quindlen excels at stories about families, this is her new one.

**John Sandford: STORM PREY.** Did Lucas's wife witness a crime?

**Scott Turow: INNOCENT.** A judge may be accused of murder...for the second time.
