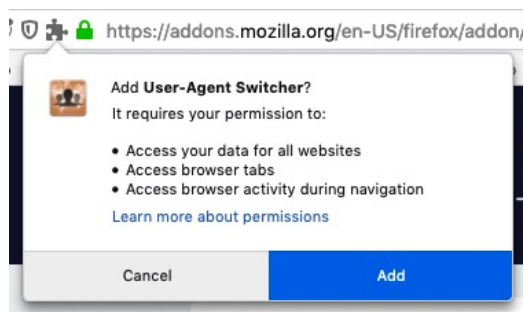


Downloading Overdrive Audiobooks with a Mac

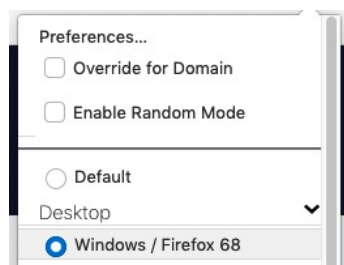
In September, Overdrive discontinued its Overdrive app for the Mac so that users can no longer download audiobooks and have to stream them through the browser. Here are instructions for downloading audiobooks to any Mac that has not yet upgraded to the Catalina operating system. Users can still download EPUBS as usual.

Note: audiobooks can NOT be downloaded to Macs running Catalina.

1. Make sure the user has the Overdrive App installed by clicking the “Available for Mac” button on this page: <https://app.overdrive.com>
2. Using the Firefox browser, get an add-on called User-Agent Switcher. This will allow your Mac to pretend to be a PC: <https://addons.mozilla.org/firefox/addon/uaswitcher/>
3. Click “add” when this dialog box comes up.



4. Find the add-on in the browser toolbar and click it to open its menu. Select “Windows/Firefox” from the menu.



5. Navigate to your Overdrive website and select/download the audiobook you want to listen to. You may need to tell the browser you want to open the file using the Overdrive app.
6. Go back to the add-on in the tool bar and set it back to “Default”
7. Happy listening!
